

Re: Notice of Commencement of Legal Action Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Challenging the City of San Buenaventura's Final EIR Certification and Approval of State Water Interconnection Project

To the Mayor and Members of the City Council:

This office represents the California Water Impact Network ("petitioner") in the above-referenced matter. Pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21167.5, please be advised that on September 4, 2019, petitioner intends to commence a legal action in the Ventura County Superior Court against the City of San Buenaventura ("City") under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Pub. Res. Code, § 21000, *et seq.*) This action will challenge, and seek to set aside, the City's certification of the Final EIR for the above-noted project, and the final project approval recorded in the City's Notice of Determination, filed by the City on August 6, 2019 and filed at the State Clearinghouse on August 12, 2019.
